ten years ago there were no faith based units in prisons outside south america today they are spreading all over the world including the united states europe and the commonwealth my brother s keeper is the first major study of a global phenomenon exploring the roots of faith based units in south america it explains why the prison service of england and wales set up the first christian based unit in the western world in 1997 and its rapid expansion it also explains how at exactly the same time the united states introduced christian based units and why they were complimented by interfaith and multifaitth initiatives at the heart of my brother s keeper is an interior account of life inside four christian based prison units in england it draws on the findings of a detailed evaluation conducted by the authors for the home office prison service and kainos community between 2000 and 2001 including an updated reconviction study it is an authoritative account of an innovative programme its analysis of what works and what doesn t in faith based units around the world makes my brother s keeper a valuable roadmap for all who care about improving prison conditions it presents a vision of justice that is not just concerned with building more prisons but with rebuilding more prisoners it argues that by making prisons more human and punishment more humane faith based units can be of value and keep faith in prisons

in this stirring book william h barnwell tells the stories of prison inmates and the kairos prison ministry volunteers who work with them set mostly at the huge louisiana state penitentiary at angola barnwell s narrative illustrates how offenders who have done the worst can and do change becoming model inmates and if released productive citizens the stories also reveal how kairos volunteers have found healing for broken hearts given that the united states incarcerates more people per capita than

any country in the world reformers are seeking radically new ways to reduce our prison populations kairos volunteers and inmates alike have much to contribute to the ongoing reform discussions now serving 300 state and federal prisons 30 000 kairos volunteers work with 20 000 inmates each year they take part in long weekend retreats with the inmates and follow up with regular prison visits since its beginning in 1976 kairos has served over 250 000 inmates broad based nondenominational and nonjudgmental christian kairos seeks to carry out its slogan listen listen love love among inmates who have had few to listen to them and fewer still to love them in called to heal the brokenhearted are stories of undeniable redemption they point the way to personal transformation for the inmates and the volunteers one kairos inmate speaks of the change this way he makes guitars out of the good wood hidden beneath the surface of throwaway pianos i find my work incredibly fulfilling he says i see myself in every piano discarded by society but redeemed and put to use in a new way

a sequel to eckardt s fascinating earlier study sitting in the earth and laughing eckardt employs a variety of historical psychological sociological philosophical and theological sources he discusses and assesses such diverse figures as martin luther reinhold niebuhr zen buddhists conrad hyers nancy a walker jon d levenson and harvey cox how to tell god from the devil is an exceptional work and will be significant and enjoyable for sociologists theologians philosophers and specialists concerned with the study of humor

if you want to go to prison just call your uncle bob because not only can i get you into prison but i can get you out of prison when you want out robert hitt neill has worked as a volunteer in the kairos prison ministry international organization for nearly two decades and has witnessed miracle after miracle in prison which he tells about in ms karotales many of these karo tales are hilarious such as the day we broke into the prison or the day we blew up the prison other karo tales will have the reader reaching for a hankie but all of these testify to a ministry whose motto is listen listen love love god has seen fit to bless this karo ministry in countless ways over the 30 years of its existence and neill tells of these blessings in his inimitable humorous and nostalgic style ms karotales is a companion book to the holy ghost has a funny bone and is intended as a fund raiser for the kairos prison ministry

this book tells the story of a partnership between two universities that spent several years exploring productive ways to engage difficult dialogues in classroom and academic settings it presents a model for a faculty development intensive strategies for engaging controversial topics in the classroom and reflections from thirty five faculty and staff members who field tested the techniques it is intended as a conversation starter and field manual for professors and teachers who want to strengthen their teaching and engage students more effectively in important conversations

this transhistorical international and interdisciplinary work will be of interest to students theater professionals and shakespeare scholars

in this thing called the world debjani ganguly theorizes the contemporary global novel and the social and historical conditions that shaped it ganguly contends that global literature coalesced into its current form in 1989 an event marked by the convergence of three major trends the consolidation of the information age the arrival of a perpetual state of global war and the expanding focus on humanitarianism ganguly analyzes a trove of novels from authors including salman rushdie don delillo michael ondatje and art spiegelman who address wars in iraq afghanistan and sri lanka the palestinian and kashmiri crises the rwandan genocide and post9 11 terrorism these novels exist in a context in which suffering s presence in everyday life is mediated through digital images and where authors integrate visual forms into their storytelling in showing how the evolution of the contemporary global novel is analogous to the european novel s emergence in the eighteenth century when society and the development of capitalism faced similar monumental ruptures ganguly provides both a theory of the contemporary moment and a reminder of the novel s power

what is time and how does it influence our knowledge of international politics for decades international relations ir paid little explicit attention to time recently this began to change as a range of scholars took an interest in the temporal dimensions of politics yet ir still has not fully addressed the issue of why time matters in international politics nor has it reflected on its own use of time how temporal ideas affect the way we work to understand political phenomena moreover ir remains beholden to two seemingly contradictory visions of time the time of the clock and a longstanding tradition treating time as a problem to be solved international relations and the problem of time develops a unique response to these interconnected puzzles it reconstructs ir s temporal imagination by developing an argument that all times from natural rhythms to individual temporal experience spring from social and practical timing activities or efforts to establish meaningful and useful relationships in

complex and dynamic settings in its case across a surprisingly wide range of approaches scholars employ narrative timing techniques to make sense of confounding processes and events this innovative account of time provides a more systematic and rigorous explanation for time in international politics it also develops provocative insights about its own history its key methodological commitments supposedly timeless statistical methods historical institutions and the critical vanguard of time studies this book invites us to reimagine time and in so doing to significantly rethink the way we approach the analysis of international politics

this is the final report of canada's truth and reconciliation commission and its six year investigation of the residential school system for aboriginal youth and the legacy of these schools this report the summary volume includes the history of residential schools the legacy of that school system and the full text of the commission's 94 recommendations for action to address that legacy this report lays bare a part of canada's history that until recently was little known to most non aboriginal canadians the commission discusses the logic of the colonization of canada's territories and why and how policy and practice developed to end the existence of distinct societies of aboriginal peoples using brief excerpts from the powerful testimony heard from survivors this report documents the residential school system which forced children into institutions where they were forbidden to speak their language required to discard their clothing in favour of institutional wear given inadequate food housed in inferior and fire prone buildings required to work when they should have been studying and subjected to emotional psychological and often physical abuse in this setting cruel punishments were all too common as was sexual abuse more than 30 000 survivors have been compensated financially by the government of canada for their experiences in residential schools but the legacy of this experience is ongoing today this report explains the links to high rates of aboriginal children being taken from their families abuse of drugs and alcohol and high rates of suicide the report documents the drastic decline in the presence of aboriginal languages even as survivors and others work to maintain their distinctive cultures traditions and governance the report offers 94 calls to action on the part of governments churches public institutions and non aboriginal canadians as a path to meaningful reconciliation of canada today with aboriginal citizens even though the historical experience of residential schools constituted an act of cultural genocide by canadian government authorities the united nation's declaration of the rights of aboriginal peoples and the specific recommendations of the commission offer a path to move from apology for these events to true reconciliation that can be embraced by all canadians

this reference guide traces the writing across the curriculum movement from its origins in british secondary education through its flourishing in american higher education and extension to american primary and secondary education

in this book sarosh koshy strives to go beyond the mission model of christianity that emerged alongside and within the colonial enterprise and ethos since the sixteenth century rather than denounce the inheritance of the mission movement that transformed both the church and world in innumerable ways it is a simultaneous expression of appreciation for this precious heritage and an attempt to do justice by it through a yearning quest for relevant paradigms of christian engagement indeed there is an intense tension within this book and in fact a twin tension at that the tension is between those seeking to keep the current mission paradigm alive out of habit or as a self serving device thus corrupting and withering away a bequeathal that essentially set free the voluntary independent spirit of christian individuals and their intentional collectives from both the ecclesiastical and political authorities on the other side are those who enlist mission both as a subsequent activity and as a basis to pursue innocuous and at times apparently heroic options that would seemingly satisfy a supposed missional mandatory this work enlists postcolonial and poststructuralist resources pedagogically to teach of mission missiology world christianity and intercultural theology

the international ecumenical peace convocation iepc organized by the world council of churches in may 2011 brought together more than 1 000 participants from more than 100 countries this historic gathering encouraged individuals and churches to renew their commitment to nonviolence and peace with justice and it gave impetus for the wider ecumenical family and its related constituencies to pursue their search for peace this book is the final report of the convocation offering an overview of the entire proceedings of the iepc from opening plenary to thematic plenaries to workshops and side events with a wealth of ideas and reflections on peace with justice the book serves not only as a record of this historic event but also as a helpful toolkit for peacemakers and an engagement with the issues and themes related to the 2013 wcc assembly theme god of life lead us to justice and peace

the third and fourth books of cicero's tusculan disputations deal with the nature and management of human emotion first grief then the emotions in general in lively and accessible style cicero presents the insights of greek philosophers on the subject reporting the views of epicureans and peripatetics and giving a detailed account of the stoic position which he himself favors for its close reasoning and moral earnestness both the specialist and the general reader will be fascinated by the stoics analysis of the causes of grief their classification of emotions by genus and species their lists of oddly named character flaws and by the philosophical debate that develops over the utility of anger in politics and war margaret graver's elegant and idiomatic translation makes cicero's work accessible not just to classicists but to anyone interested in ancient philosophy and psychotherapy or in the philosophy of emotion the accompanying commentary explains the philosophical concepts discussed in the text and supplies many helpful parallels from greek sources

this ground breaking text offers a fresh perspective on the governance of science from the standpoint of social and political

theory science has often been seen as the only institution that embodies the elusive democratic ideal of the open society yet science remains an elite activity that commands much more public trust than understanding even though science has become increasingly entangled with larger political and economic issues
